The Gaithersburg Financial Empowerment Center (FEC) provides free, confidential financial counseling to Gaithersburg residents as a public service of the City.

Financial counselors help residents reduce debt, increase savings, improve credit, and connect to safe and affordable banking.

The program is a partnership between the City of Gaithersburg and Housing Initiative Partnership Inc, an innovative housing nonprofit. The FEC opened in March 2022 with a grant from Cities for Financial Empowerment.

Why financial empowerment?


