

Thank you for your interest in the HRAP program. Due to its popularity, we have decided to close the waitlist. We are no longer accepting names for the waitlist at this time, however, if your name is already on the waitlist, it will remain there. Please check back in at a later time to see if we have opened up the list again.

Please be aware that we are able to service anywhere from 15-20 homes per year and our waitlist has over 400 names.

## **Details about HRAP:**

- HRAP is a loan program (in the future, it may incorporate some grants).
- HRAP is NOT an emergency program- we operate on a first-come first-serve basis only.
- HRAP addresses critical repairs for hazards, safety, accessibility and weatherization first. It is not a cosmetic program.
- Once sent an application, it is your responsibility to get documents back in a timely manner.
- Once an inspector is sent to your home, it takes about 1 year to get to signing closing loan documents before construction starts.
- The Department for Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and the Redevelopment Authority (RDA) have final say on whether an application is approved.
